### Conditions

#### 1. Pitches

All pitches are on marked plots to the size ordered. Craft traders **must** ensure that all tables and displays, etc fall within their pitch. The allocation of pitches will be on a first come, first served basis unless the Rally decides otherwise. Every endeavour will be made to allocate sites fairly but no changes of position are allowed.

#### 2. Insurance and Claims

All craft traders shall have public liability insurance to cover their activities for a limit of indemnity of not less than £1,000,000 for any one accident. The officials, members or representatives of Earls Barton Rally (hereafter, "**The Rally**") accept no liability for the loss or damage to the property or vehicle belonging to the craft trader – however such loss or damage occurs. The craft trader shall be responsible for any loss or damage caused by their presence on the site. **Please enclose a copy of your public liability insurance certificate with your application.**

#### 3. Services

Limited supplies of electricity will be available at the rate stated above.

#### 4. Opening Times

On-site trading may commence from 8-00am but all stands **must** be open for business by 10-00am each day. All stands must remain open until 6-00pm (unless by prior arrangement) when **all** trading should cease.

#### 5. Setting up and Clearance

All stands must be erected by 9-30am on the first day – no access for stand construction will be possible after that time. All craft traders must clear their pitch fully (including litter) on the last day of the event.

#### 6. Litter

All craft traders are responsible for the clearance of litter on or in front of their pitch, each day and at the close of the event. All large litter must be removed from the site.

#### 7. Fire Precautions

All traders must provide their own fire extinguishers of an appropriate type. Advice is available from the Rally Safety Officer.

#### 8. Vehicles

One vehicle pass will be issued to each trader to permit access on to the Rally site. On public opening days vehicles must be removed from the event area by 9-45 am at the latest and will not be allowed back on site until 6-00pm each afternoon..

#### 9. Fees and Acceptance

Fees are in accordance with the rates given in the event information and are not subject to VAT. Receipts will be issued following receipt of the rent. Fees will be returned in full if your application is not accepted. No fees will be returned to any craft trader who fails to attend.

#### 10. Interpretation and amendment of these conditions

The Rally reserves the right to amend these conditions but are not liable for any additional restrictions imposed by the landowner at any time. Traders will be notified of any changes to these conditions as soon at the earliest opportunity.
