| <p>1. <i>Pitches</i> All pitches are on marked plots to the size ordered. Exhibitors must ensure that all tables and displays, etc fall within their pitch. The allocation of pitches will be on a first come, first served basis unless the Rally decides otherwise. Every endeavour will be made to allocate sites fairly but no changes of position are allowed.</p> <p>2. <i>Insurance and Claims</i> All exhibitors must have public liability insurance to cover their activities for a limit of indemnity of not less than £1,000,000 for any one accident. The officials, members or representatives of Earls Barton Rally (hereafter, 'The Rally') accept no liability for the loss or damage to the property or vehicle belonging to the exhibitor – however such loss or damage occurs. The exhibitor shall be responsible for any loss or damage caused by their presence on the site. Please enclose a copy of your public liability insurance certificate with your application.</p> <p>3. <i>Setting up and Clearance</i> All stands must be in place by 9-30am each day – no access for stand construction will be possible after that time. Exhibits must remain in place until 6-00pm (unless by prior arrangement). All exhibits must cleared fully on the last day of the event.</p> <p>4. <i>Litter</i> All Exhibitors are responsible for the clearance of litter on or in front of their stand, each day and at the close of the event.</p> <p>5. <i>Fire Precautions</i> All exhibitors must provide their own fire extinguishers of an appropriate type. Advice is available from the Rally Safety Officer.</p> <p>6. <i>Vehicles</i> One vehicle pass will be issued to each exhibitor to permit access on to the Rally site. On public opening days vehicles must be removed from the event area by 9-45 am at the latest and will not be allowed back on site until 6-00pm each afternoon..</p> <p>7. <i>Interpretation and amendment of these conditions</i> The Rally reserves the right to amend these conditions but are not liable for any additional restrictions imposed by the landowner at any time. Traders will be notified of any changes to these conditions as soon at the earliest opportunity.</p> <p>8. <i>Dog Fouling</i> Dogs must be kept on a close lead and Dog fouling is the responsibility of the owner to remove. Local byelaws allow a fine of £50 and this will be enforced.</p> |
