Conditions of Entry

- All exhibits shall have **Public Liability Insurance** to cover their activities for a limit of no less than £2,000,000 for any accident. The organisers accept no liability for the loss or damage to the property or vehicle belonging to the exhibitor. However, if such loss or damage is caused by the exhibitor by their presence on the site, they shall be responsible for any loss or damage. Please enclose a copy of your **Public Liability Insurance Certificate** with your application form or present it to the **Safety Officer** on arrival.
- Upon arrival at the event site, all exhibitors are required to park in their allocated pitch prior to booking in at **RALLY CONTROL**.
- All exhibits must be in steam or on show (as appropriate) by 10.30am and remain so until 5.30pm.
- Event plaques will be exchanged for the exhibit card providing the same exhibit has attended on two out of the three days.
- BBQ'S are permitted but must be off the ground to avoid burning the grass. Open fires and the burning of wood on BBQ'S is strictly prohibited.
- Dogs must be kept on a close lead and **Dog fouling is the responsibility of the owner to remove**. Local byelaws allowing a fine of £50 will be enforced.
